Certificate in Academic English Level 1 (Beginner-Intensive)

Outline:

The aim of this course level is to help students develop confidence in using English and to develop a passion for learning English. The level introduces absolute beginners or those with a little English to a good foundation for everyday English through a step-by-step approach, building on skills and confidence. The teaching methodologies include the four main language skills; reading, writing, listening and speaking, as well as role-play and audiovisual activities.

- 6. The use of simple prepositions of time and location.
- 7. The use of pronouns in sentences.
- 8. Possessives including possessive adjectives and pronouns.
- 9. Past Simple of regular and irregular verbs in positive and negative sentences and questions.
- 10. The use of the modal "can" for ability and making requests.
- 11. The Present Continuous tense in positive and negative sentences and questions.
- 12. The Present Continuous used to express the future in positive and negative sentences and questions.
