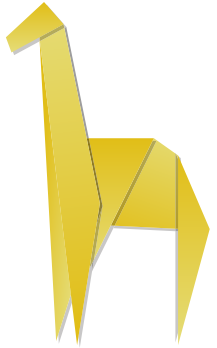


## Origami by Kirill



Origami is the ancient art of paper folding. This activity engages our student Kirill from Primary 2A, and sneakily enhances his skills like sequential thinking, fractions, problem-solving, and fun science.

And of course, it brings all of us a lot of fun. There are different kinds

of books, videos, and apps with many beautiful kid-friendly origami. The folding instructions are clear, well-illustrated, and easy to follow. 'Start simple and see how the magic happens,' says Milana Alymova (Kirill's mom).

Active learning can take place when a child plays sports, spends time with family and friends, acts in a school play, plays a musical instrument or visits museums and bookstores. The best way to promote active learning is to listen to children's ideas and respond to them. They should be allowed to question and their opinions be heard while reading books together. When this type of give-and-take is encouraged at home, a child's participation and interest in school is likely to increase.

家长可透过运动、让小孩与朋友家人相处、乐器弹奏 或带孩子参观博物馆或书局，来激发孩子自发性学习。促进自发性学习的最好方法是倾听孩子的想法，并对此作出回应。当他们在阅读书籍时，允许他们提问和发表意见。同时，也鼓励家长可在家里多与孩子使用这种互动性问答模式，那将会提高孩子在学校的参与性及学习兴趣。

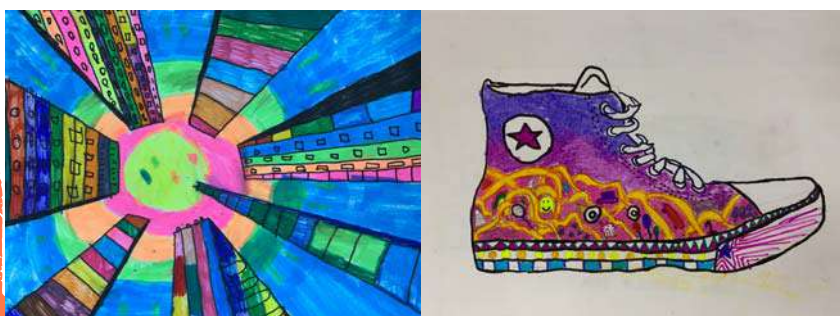

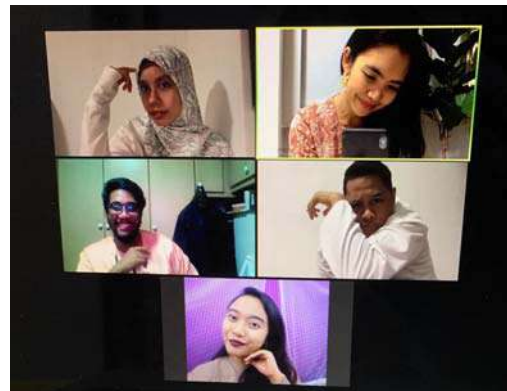
